

Katie Robotham



Introduce yourself? Tell us all about Katie?

Katie: So some formalities...Settle in peeps... Yep...that's me, Katie, the owner and creator of "SAY YES BRIDAL STYLIST" Bridal & Event hair specialist based in the Cotswolds, UK.

A 33YO award winning Bridal hair stylist, wife, mum to two human and two fur babies, my 12 yo lab Buddy and my 4yo cocker Merlot (yes named after the wine!) who mission it is to help you embrace my couples individuality and create fashion forward alternative relaxed modern bridal looks.

I'm definitely a creative person who loves wine ₹, chocolate �, long dog walks in the countryside, and a little bit obsessed with Below deck! ≜

I have over 35,000 hours of mastery in creating unique alternative bridal looks for brides of all styles. Specializing in whimsical bohemian looks with a unique twist, I will work with you to ensure you look and feel your authentic self. I want my couples to have the best morning, so I love to bring the energy and have fun. I love creating content, so I will try and capture you some of those special

wedding morning moments and of cause a tiktok transition or two! I also do anything I can to help their morning run as smoothly as possible, including pouring drinks, getting you dressed, sorting your flowers, and putting on button holes. I love meeting people and creating connections, and have launched a wedding podcast "i do and updos" with my cohost- Laura Crockett Celebrant to help showcase unique wedding suppliers and inspire couples to add unique elements to their day (would love if you can take a listen). I love animals of all kind but my favorite is giraffes. I love to travel when I can, Italy is my favorite place in Europe. I absolutely LOVE wine- particularly red. My house is never out, there is always a bottle just in case we need to celebrate.

What's one thing brides are often suprised to learn about you?

Katie: I'm half American! I look and sound as English as they come, but im half american on my dads side. I have a huge family in America, He was one of 5 children, but over here in England, there is me, my mum and my stepdad.

What inspired you to start 'Say Yes Bridal Stylist'? How did your passion for sustainable and cruelty free - beauty evolve?

Katie: I have a deep love for our beautiful world and everything in it, which makes sustainability a core value in both my personal life and my work. I've been a hairstylist since 2007, starting out as a Saturday girl and working my way up to salon management. Over the years, I've managed four different salons.

During the last COVID lockdown, we relocated to the Cotswolds for my husband's job. With salons closed and no local connections, I found myself at a crossroads. It was the perfect time to combine my two true passions: bridal hair and conscious living. That's how Say Yes Bridal Stylist was born a vegan, cruelty-free, and sustainable brand that encourages clients to "Say Yes" to ethic bridal beauty. I only use products that are recycled, biodegradable, cruelty-free, and vegan-friendly. I've made many changes in my business practices to reduce environmental impact, including planting one tree for every wedding day booking. It's my way of giving back while helping brides and couples feel beautiful in the most mindful way possible.

What does 'authentic bridal beauty' mean to you?

Katie: There's a lot of pressure to look and feel perfect on your wedding day. Many couples feel the need to look the best they ever have, especially with the internet overflowing with "bridal inspiration." It can start to feel like there's a specific way to look like a bride or couple, as if you have to fit a mold to feel worthy of the title.

But I believe your wedding day should reflect you. Your personality, your style, your story. It's easy to lose sight of that in the noise, which is why I aim to help my couples feel confident and be fully themselves. When you embrace who you are, you naturally shine.

How do you tailor your style to reflect each bride's personality?

Katie: I work closely with every bride or couple from the very first enquiry right up to those special moments before they walk down the aisle. It all begins with a discovery call, where I take the time to truly get to know them and understand the vision for their day.

From there, we move into an exclusive bridal preview, where each style is carefully tailored to suit the nearlywed's unique look, personality, and wedding vibe. I always encourage bringing along inspiration photos, and we chat through any key details that might influence their style; from the outfit and setting to weather, timings, and more.

We'll also talk through their expectations for the day, any hair accessories they may want, and I offer help with sourcing, ordering, and even colour-matching hair extensions or accessories if needed.

After the preview, I always follow up to see how felt about the look once they've had time to reflect. If they change their mind or want to tweak anything, I'm happy to offer another bridal preview to make sure they feel completely confident and relaxed going into their big day.

What is your price range?

Katie: I tailor every package to my nearly wed making it bespoke to them, but my starting fee is £450 plus travel- this includes a Bride or nearly wed, plus 2 bridal party on the day styling, a bridal preview for the nearly wed and a touch up kitbag left with them on the day.

You can also add color matching and ordering of hair extensions, bridal hair accessories from my own collection and additional bridal party members if you require larger party styling. I will also arrange an assistant to help me and your bridal party if required.



How long have you been working in the wedding industry and how do you feel about the industry being so wasteful?

Kate: I founded Say Yes Bridal Stylist back in November 2020, in the last lockdown, and as we all know covid really shone a light on disposable waste items. I absolutely hate how wasteful the wedding industry is, however it's also unavoidable at times; for example hygiene reasons with disposable single use make up wands for eyes etc. I have also discovered some incredible wedding businesses that are as eco conscious as I am and who really have embraced more sustainable practices within their business. From hiring your florals, to reloved wedding dresses, sustainable photographers and upcycling furniture these businesses have really helped to make an impact to change and encourage their couples to embrace it too. Just making small changes to your wedding day can really help with the environmental impact whilst also making your day epic.

How many hair trails would you recommend and what do brides need to bring with them for a hair trail?

Kate: I always recommend that brides and nearlyweds narrow their hairstyle options down to two styles for their bridal preview. This gives us the perfect opportunity to explore what works best for you without feeling overwhelmed by too many choices. Ideally, your preview should take place 3 to 6 months before the big day – by then, most of the key details are usually confirmed, and you'll have a clearer vision of your overall wedding vibe.

If you try both styles and still feel unsure, I'm more than happy to offer a second bridal preview if needed. That said, if it's just a few small tweaks, another full session usually isn't necessary. I always encourage bringing along any hair accessories or veils you've already purchased or borrowed so we can see how everything works together. It helps to create a cohesive final look. It's also a great idea to bring photos or videos of your outfit, especially close-ups of any detailing. This allows us to match accessories and styling to your dress's or outfits unique features. If you haven't bought your hair accessories yet,

I'd recommend waiting until after your preview, in case the style you choose doesn't suit your initial accessory ideas. But if you've fallen in love with something though, go for it – sometimes those pieces are too good to miss!

Finally, try wearing a top with a similar neckline, shape, and colour to your wedding outfit during your preview. This makes it much easier to visualise your complete look and how everything will come together on the day.

Do you offer hair extensions?

Kate: Yes, absolutely! If your chosen style requires added volume or length, I recommend using clip-in hair extensions. I work with Clip Hair, a trusted brand offering ethically sourced, 100% human hair extensions.

During your bridal preview, I provide colour matching to ensure a seamless blend with your natural hair. I also bring along a few sample sets for you to try, so you can get a feel for how they'll look and feel on the day. If you decide to go ahead, I can handle the ordering, prepping, and styling of the extensions so everything is ready to go on your wedding morning.

Tell us why our brides should choose you to be their bridal hairstylist?

Kate: If you're looking for a bridal hairstylist who is highly organised, reliable, warm, and genuinely invested in creating the perfect wedding morning atmosphere, all while celebrating you for exactly who you are-then I'm the stylist for you. I'm here to make sure you feel relaxed, supported, and completely yourself, without compromise.

Where are you based?

Kate: Based in Stow on the wold: North Cotswolds, but also cover the nearby "shires" – Herefordshire, Worcestershire, Warwickshire, Gloucestershire, Oxfordshire, Wiltshire and internationally in Europe.

What are you known for ? What is your signature hair do? Your favourite bridal look to create?

Kate: I'm a boho queen at heart, with a true love for creating relaxed, whimsical, and romantic efforless styles. My signature looks include everything from effortless textured buns to beachy half-up, half-down styles, always with a unique twist that's tailored just for you. I especially love working with beautiful natural curls and embracing that lived-in, free-spirited vibes that makes each look feel perfect to you.

How has becoming a mother influenced your work or creativity?

Kate: Becoming a mother was truly life-changing for me, as it is for so many. It's made me more resilient, grounded, and able to embrace the chaos with a calm mindset. I've developed more patience than ever and learned to stay steady even when things don't go exactly to plan.

These qualities naturally flow into my work. I thrive under pressure, work seamlessly with other suppliers, and help keep the wedding morning running smoothly. From organising the bridal party to ensuring everyone is on time and stressfree, I'm there to support you every step of the way.

Can you share a styling moment that really moved you?

Kate: Over the years ive been honoured to be able to witness so many special moments on a wedding morning that my couples experienced, but two in particular stand out to me.

One that really stayed with me was a quiet moment between a bride and her dad. All the bridesmaids had already left for the ceremony, and it was just the two of them in the room. Her dad walked in carrying two glasses and a bottle of whisky, a special one the bride had gifted him year after year for his birthday. They had a tradition of only opening it to celebrate meaningful moments together, and this was one of the biggest. They shared a quiet toast before heading out a simple, beautiful ritual that spoke volumes about their bond.

Another unforgettable moment happened while I

was doing a bridesmaid's hair. I just happened to be filming some content when the bride walked in holding an envelope for her mum. I instinctively turned the camera toward them, not knowing I was about to capture something so touching. The mother of the bride opened the envelope, read the note inside, and immediately began to cry. They embraced, and through tears, her mum said, "I always wanted a girl. I didn't get the chance to have more children, but that's okay- you are all I ever could have asked for." It wasn't until I reviewed the footage at home that I truly heard the audio and took in the moment. I was in tears -it was one of those rare, beautiful exchanges that I'll never forget. Moments like these remind me how lucky I am to do what I do.

What is an eco conscious hairstylist?

Kate: An eco-conscious hairstylist is a hairstylist who actively works to reduce their environmental impact through thoughtful, sustainable, and ethical practices in their work. This means considering how every product, tool, and service affects the planet, animals, and people. Its a hairstylist who actively changes their practises to become more sustainable.

Why is sustainability so important to you?

Kate: Sustainability is really important to me as I believe a small change is better than no change at all. We all need to do our bit to protect the planet and its future, with all the beauty it holds our future and our children.

What steps do you take to ensure your services are eco-conscious?

Kate: Each year, I carefully review and refine my practices to ensure my work stays as sustainable as possible. From carrying a mini bin with me to responsibly manage and recycle waste on the go, to partnering with Ecologi and planting a tree for every bridal booking to help offset my carbon footprint, sustainability is at the heart of everything I do.

All of the products I use come from brands that share my values, prioritising eco-friendly practices such as eco friendly packaging. Every item in my kit is vegan, cruelty-free, and chosen with sustainability in mind, so you can feel confident your wedding hair is both beautiful and kind to the planet.

How do you source your vegan and cruelty free products?

Kate: During my time as a salon manager, I had the opportunity to work with some incredible brands that place sustainability at the heart of their mission. I've also done extensive research into leading eco-conscious brands that don't just talk the talk - they deliver exceptional product quality too.

Brands like Color Wow, Maria Nila, and For Reasons truly embrace ethical and sustainable practices across every aspect of their business, making them trusted staples in my kit.

What is your proudest moment as a stylist so far?

Kate: There have been a few moments throughout the last 5 years that ive been proud of but my two standout moments are winning the south west wedding awards 2024 and launching my podcast "i do and updos. Both have been a dream of mine and last year I managed to achieve both!

What's a typical wedding morning like for you?

Kate: This is a tricky one, as timelines can vary quite a bit from wedding to wedding, but I do have a well-honed routine that keeps things running smoothly.

The night before, I prep everything: stock is checked, the car is fuelled, alarms are set, and I double-check the location so I know exactly where I'm headed. I always build in an extra 30 minutes of travel time, just in case I get lost (which does happen - I've ended up in a field thanks to a rogue postcode more than once, and yes, I've even jumped a fence or two in the dark to reach an Airbnb or bridal prep location!). I bring along my hydro flask, pack a lunch, and defrost one of Emily English's delicious "palpable breakfast muffins" the night before to stay fuelled, healthy and to avoid being tempted by a leftover croissant. I hate being hangry on a wedding morning! On the day, I allow 15 minutes for setup. When planning your timeline, I



recommend:

45 minutes per bridal party member 1 hour to 1 hour 15 minutes for the bride or nearlywed

Plus any additional time if I need to relocate between prep spaces

I always leave the final hour before the ceremony as buffer time -this is when everything tends to happen at once: touch-ups, getting into dresses, toilet breaks, last-minute photos... it's often the most intense hour of the morning!

Once the bride or nearlywed heads off to meet the registrar, that's usually my cue to quietly pack down and head off, unless I'm staying on to create a second look later in the day.

How do you stay calm and keep the energy positive on such a big day?

Kate: Something small almost always goes offplan on a wedding morning – and that's completely normal. I pride myself on staying calm and level-headed, even in the middle of chaos. Having been a bride myself, I truly understand how overwhelming the morning can feel, and I'm tuned in to those subtle signs of stress or anxiety.

I regularly check in throughout the morning to see how my nearlywed is feeling and offer support in any way I can, whether that's building in extra time for a quick venue check, pouring a calming drink, or simply offering a quiet moment to breathe. It's the little things that make a big difference.

I also bring a speaker in my kit bag so the vibe stays upbeat and relaxed with the nearly-wed getting to set the mood with their own playlist. It's all about creating a calm, fun, and memorable start to an unforgettable day.

Do you have any rituals or must haves in your kit

Kate: No rituals, but my "must have kit items": I always carry an "oh shit" kit bag with me for all those last minute "darn I forget this" moments-from superglue to boob tape, to mints and tampons, it's all in there. You will also always find a bottle of Color wow dream coat and firm hold hairspray and a bottle of anti humidity protection spray to keep those frizz free locks at bay, i dont go anywhere without these.


Who walked you down the aisle?



Amy: We haven't! The wedding was a wedding and honeymoon rolled into one!




Would you have done the day differently?

Amy: Is there anything you would have changed? No - I just wish I could do it all again - it goes so quickly!



















Did you have help with Planning or Styling?

Sophie: No I wanted a very low key wedding and so there wasn't too much that needed to be planned/ styled. The hotel were great though when it came to setting up the room where we actually got married in.

How did you choose your Photographer?

Sophie: We looked online for local photographers who specialised in small/ elopement weddings. We found Dan's instagram page and his photos looked great.

Describe your Big Day?

Sophie: It was just what I wanted. We were so lucky that the weather was clear and sunny (although cold!) and we had a wonderful breakfast in the hotel before heading off into St Ives to buy the flowers. - Let nature and season set the mood.



It makes promising to do it all again even more special.

What do you plan to do with your wedding dress?

Danielle: I am planning to have it dry cleaned and sell it to another eco bride - she definitely deserves another run down the aisle!

Kirsty: I haven't touched it yet but I plan to have the dress dry cleaned and then decide.














































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Coping with pre wedding stress, wedding day nerves 8 postwedding blues.


Stress and difficulty are unavoidable parts of life. However, with the right tools and strategies, you can take back control.

Take us on your journey (tell us about how you found the shop building, your first styled shoot and launch event)

Mo: Some brides discover their gown quicker than Queen Charlotte can raise an eyebrow — others delight in trying on half a dozen or more before their heart whispers this is the one. There's no set number, but like any great love story, when the moment arrives, they'll simply know.
